

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I register? To register for a Super Partner event, please email or call to verify availability and reserve your spot:

Can I bring a guest? We love friends! However, our program is always first and foremost for YOU, our Tennessee State Bank Super Partner members. The only exception is......A TSB Super Partner member who would typically attend independently is allowed to bring one non-member guest.

What does the RSVP represent? The RSVP date represents the last date to register for an event, provided a spot is available.

What is a "Wait List"? Events, day trips, and extended trips may have a 'waiting list' due to limited space or lots of interest, or the number of spaces available at the original purchase time. Due to the number of spaces available, an event may sell out before you have had a chance to register. In the case you find yourself on a waitlist, don't get discouraged—it's not uncommon for other Super Partners to cancel which then makes these spots available for you.

How do I pay? At the time of registration, your payment options will be to pay

1) by debiting your TSB account or

2) by check and credit cards are not accepted

What is the refund policy? If you need to cancel your reservation after the RSVP date, contact Barbara or Dwinita to discuss refund options—keep in mind the refunds after the RSVP date are not guaranteed.
